Computer Services: Workshop covering how to incorporate the use of the District's Go-to-Meeting and Go-to-Training software.

This presentation provides a step-by-step guide for contacting next-of-kin, and determining, arranging, and conducting the appropriate funeral or memorial service. It includes details on proceedings and protocol required when a flotilla member dies.

Team Members trained through this program have served as a force multiplier during events such as the 2016 Democratic National Convention in Philadelphia, the 2017 Presidential Inauguration and Joint Session of Congress, as well as Sector Delaware Bay's 2017 Hurricane Exercise.

New Member Development Course: This course is designed for selected new members and is the first course in the Leadership Development Continuum. This course is satisfies the training required to hold elected office.

Intro to Public Affairs/Social Media: Overview of Auxiliary Public Affair Specialist Ratings and then Social Media. This class reviews the history and development of Social Media and identifies its uses within the Auxiliary. Interactive discussions include appropriate topics for inclusion on Auxiliary Social Media platforms, rules of engagement in Social Media and methodologies of Auxiliary communication. The session is required for Public Affairs Officers serving as moderators of their unit's Social Media outlets.

Mascot Training/PQS: The Auxiliary has a highly effective Public Affairs tools in our mascots— Sammy the Sea Otter and Coastie the Safety Boat. 
