
Parallel Search


Criteria:


- v Used to cover large search areas.
- Provides uniform coverage.
- v Usually the best pattern when using more than one search unit.

Execution:


v Search legs are parallel to the major axis.








Search Leg is along Major axis



Track
Spacing
is along
Minor
axis


The Search and Rescue Mission Coordinator (SMC) provides:


- v Commence Search Point (CSP)
 - v Where you begin
 - v Lat and Lon



SMC also provides:

- v Search leg length
- Track Spacing (separation)
 - This will be the distance between parallel search tracks
