


Track Line Single-Unit Return Search

Characteristics:

- Used when the only information available is the intended route (track) of the target
- v There is a good starting point
- Usually consists of two search legs, one on either side of the intended route
- v SRU completes search back at the CSP






Track Line Single-Unit Return Search

The Search and Rescue Mission Coordinator (SMC) provides:

v Commence Search Point (CSP)

- v Where you begin
- v Lat and Lon
- **v** Description

v Also, where to turn back



Expanding Square Search

SMC also provides:

v Track Spacing (separation)

- v This will be the distance between parallel search tracks
- V ¹/₂ track space will be the distance between a search track and the target's intended track
